

# RULES

1. All the articles for the competition must be grown, made or prepared by the exhibitor (with the exception of Classes 38 - 41 inclusive). Pot plants must have been in the possession of the exhibitor before the 1st July. Any person exhibiting articles not personally grown, made or prepared shall forfeit all prizes gained at the Show. No article previously shown at the Wansford Show may be exhibited.
2. Full time professional gardeners enter Open Classes only
3. a) The secretary and assistants will be in attendance in the marquee at the Haycock Park on Thursday 26 August 2021 to receive entry forms and entry fees between the hours of 5.00pm and 8.00pm. If entry forms are ready earlier in the week commencing 23 August 2021 they may be handed in or sent to Quentin Arnold at Wedgwood Cottage, 19 Elton Rd, Wansford, PE8 6JD
3. b) Exhibitors shall pay an entry fee: Members = 20p, Non-members = 30p Children = 10p per Exhibit which must accompany the entry form. **No entries will be accepted after 8.00pm on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2021.** Exhibitors can make as many entries as they like in any class, however no exhibitor can win more than 2 prizes in any one class.
3. c) **All photography entries are to be handed in on or before 8pm on Thursday 26 August 2021.**
3. d) The exhibits can be placed in the marquee between 9.00 am and 10.30 am on the morning of the Show, and can only be brought to the marquee on Saturday morning.
4. The Judges need not make an award when the specimens presented for exhibition are not considered worthy of a prize.
5. Entries in the Cookery Section and Drinks Class may be tasted by the Judge.
6. No article shall be removed before 5.00pm. All entries not cleared away by 5.30pm the same night shall be considered the property of the Committee and may be sold in aid of Society funds. Prize money not collected by 5.30pm may be forfeited.

7. The Committee accepts no responsibility for accidents to competitors or spectators however arising, nor will it be responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever to exhibitors or to any goods of competitors or spectators.
8. All Cups and Trophies are to be returned CLEANED and ready for presentation please to: Gary Punter at Goss Cottage, Elton Road, Wansford before Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2021
